

Facebook Group Community Guidelines





COME AS YOU ARE

At 64 Million Artists we believe everyone is creative. Whether you consider yourself creative or are beginning your journey with creativity, we welcome you to join us. In this community we strive to create positive and welcoming spaces for discussion, encouragement and connection.

SAFETY

We will not tolerate racism, ableism, transphobia, homophobia or sexism. We will not tolerate any bullying or prejudiced comments in this space, including, but not limited to, discrimination against: age, race and ethnicity, class, disability, gender, neurodiversity, religion or belief.

If you see or receive an offensive comment, please report it and we will usually take the following steps:

- Delete the comment from the group.
 - Give a warning to the person who made the comment and explain why it is inappropriate.
 - If necessary, remove the person from the Facebook group.
 - We will always try to give feedback on why we've removed posts or people from the group.

SHARING & PARTICIPATING

- This group is a place for participants to share their responses to Creative Challenges, and the creative endeavours that come with that. **This group is not a place to sell work or promote a service or event.** Your post will be removed if it is not relevant to the group topics.
- We use creativity as a vessel for authentic and expressive discussions, that might also be sensitive or private. **Confidentiality is key** - what is shared in the space, stays in the space. **If there is something you would like to share outside of the group, it is essential you receive consent before doing so.**
- Be mindful of what you post, we all have different experiences and stories that you may want to share with your challenge response. But please be aware of sensitive topics that you may be including and the effects it could have on others. **Consider including a content warning in your post if you discuss sensitive topics** i.e body image, abuse, violence.
- Authentic, expressive discussions make groups great, but may also be sensitive and private. Social Media is a public space, although this group is private, please be wary of what you are comfortable sharing with a large online community, and **please do not share any sensitive personal details such as email addresses, phone numbers and home addresses.**
- Our challenge programmes promote everyday creativity and the positive impact it can have on our wellbeing when we take part. Although this group exists to provide encouragement and connection through creativity, please note we cannot offer emotional support in the group. **If you need support you can talk to our friends at CALM about anything** - Find out more **here.**
